AgriScience - Students explore science as it relates to agriculture in relation to natural resources, plants and animals. They also develop an understanding of the importance of agriculture to the economy. Students that want to be in FFA are required to take agriscience sometime throughout the school year.

Art - Students are introduced to different mediums, artists and their styles. The projects include, perspective, 3-D abstract using 3-D glasses, paper mache masks, chalk pastel animals, contour line with silver sharpie and watercolor.

Band - Prerequisite 6th grade band - Students will move into the intermediate level. Students will play a more challenging variety of music and have many chances to perform. Masting more musical skills opens the door to really making some great music.

Choir - Students will sing and explore music from different time periods, genres, and cultures. Students will learn about proper singing technique, breathing, and style. Choir students will perform a concert with the other Choirs at the end of the grading period. Students will also have the opportunity to audition for and attend honor choirs outside of class.

Computers - This class concentrates on reinforcing keying skills by creating documents such as letters, memos, reports, tables, flyers, etc. The class utilizes Microsoft Office to prepare professional looking word processing and presentation documents. Students will also gain certification in digital literacy and responsibility by completing an online interactive simulation sponsored by Everfi.

Music Appreciation - Students will explore several music genres and learn to play various instruments

Spanish - Students will expand their knowledge of topics covered in 6th grade with emphasis on more communication. Students will study more Spanish-speaking countries and their cultures. Students will also study the Mayan civilization. 6th grade Spanish is not a prerequisite for 7th grade Spanish.

Technology - Students will have an opportunity to explore areas of interest and hands-on activities related to the field of Technology. Students will also have the opportunity to explore working with and programming portable motorized robots.

World Languages - Students will be introduced to various languages and cultures around the world. Students will explore traditions and customs of various regions.
